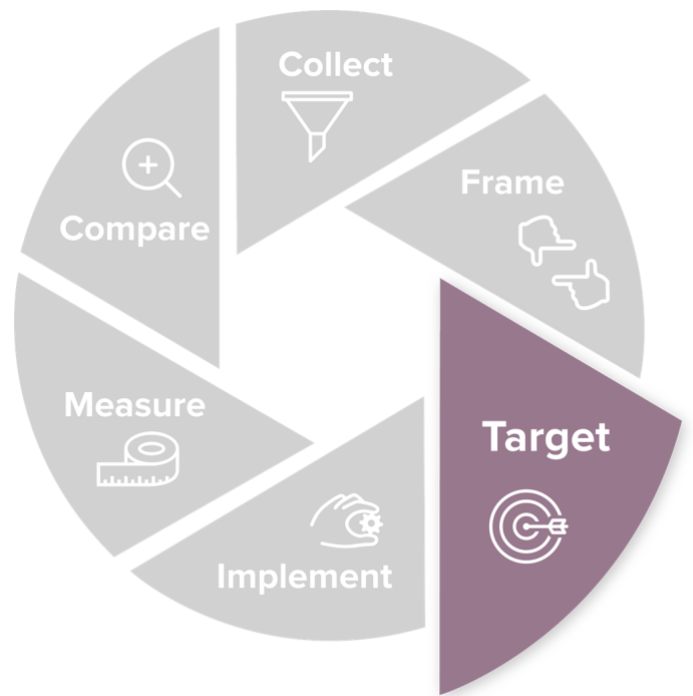

# COVID-19 Cases by County

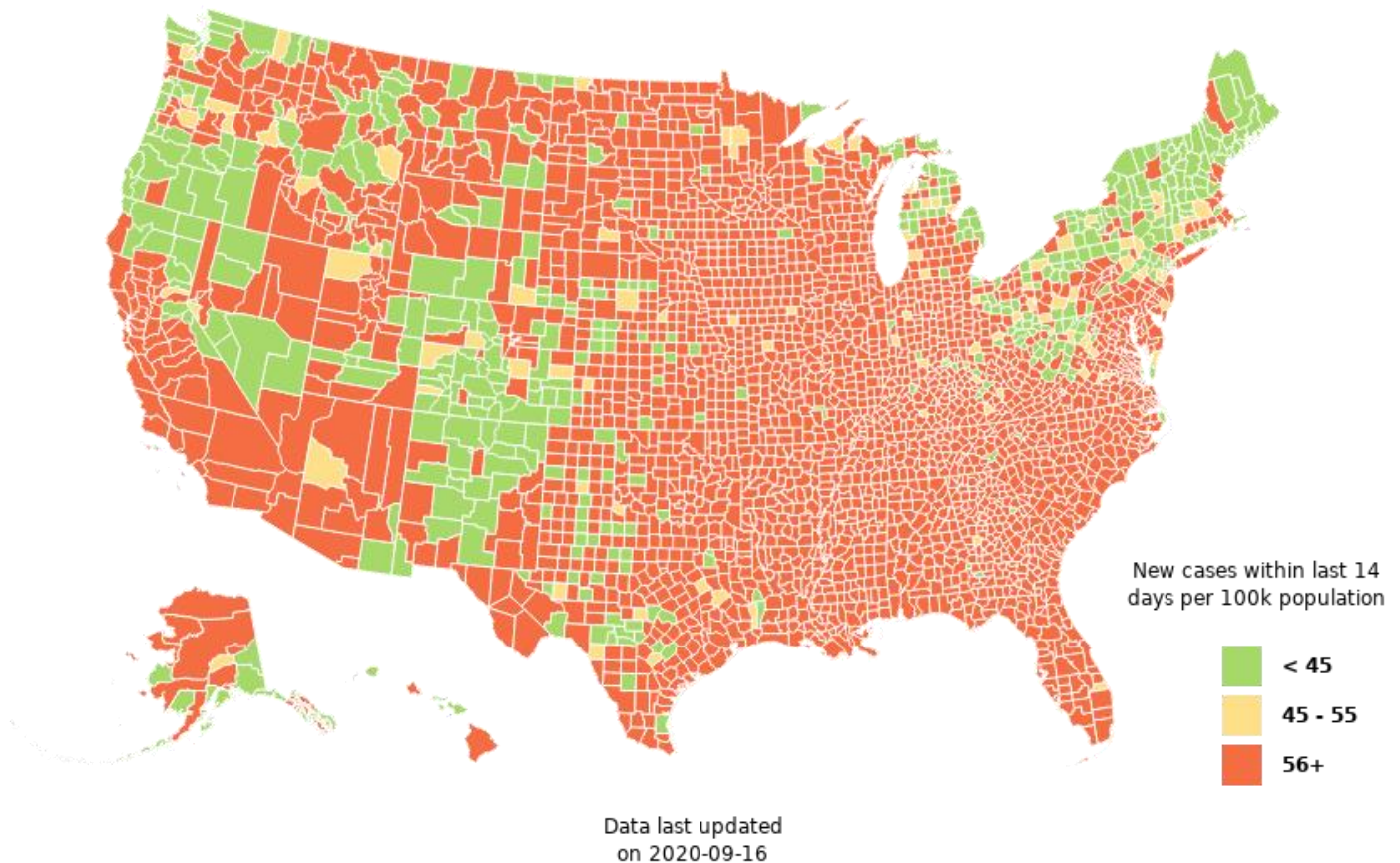
14 Day Rolling New Case Count



## I – United States of America

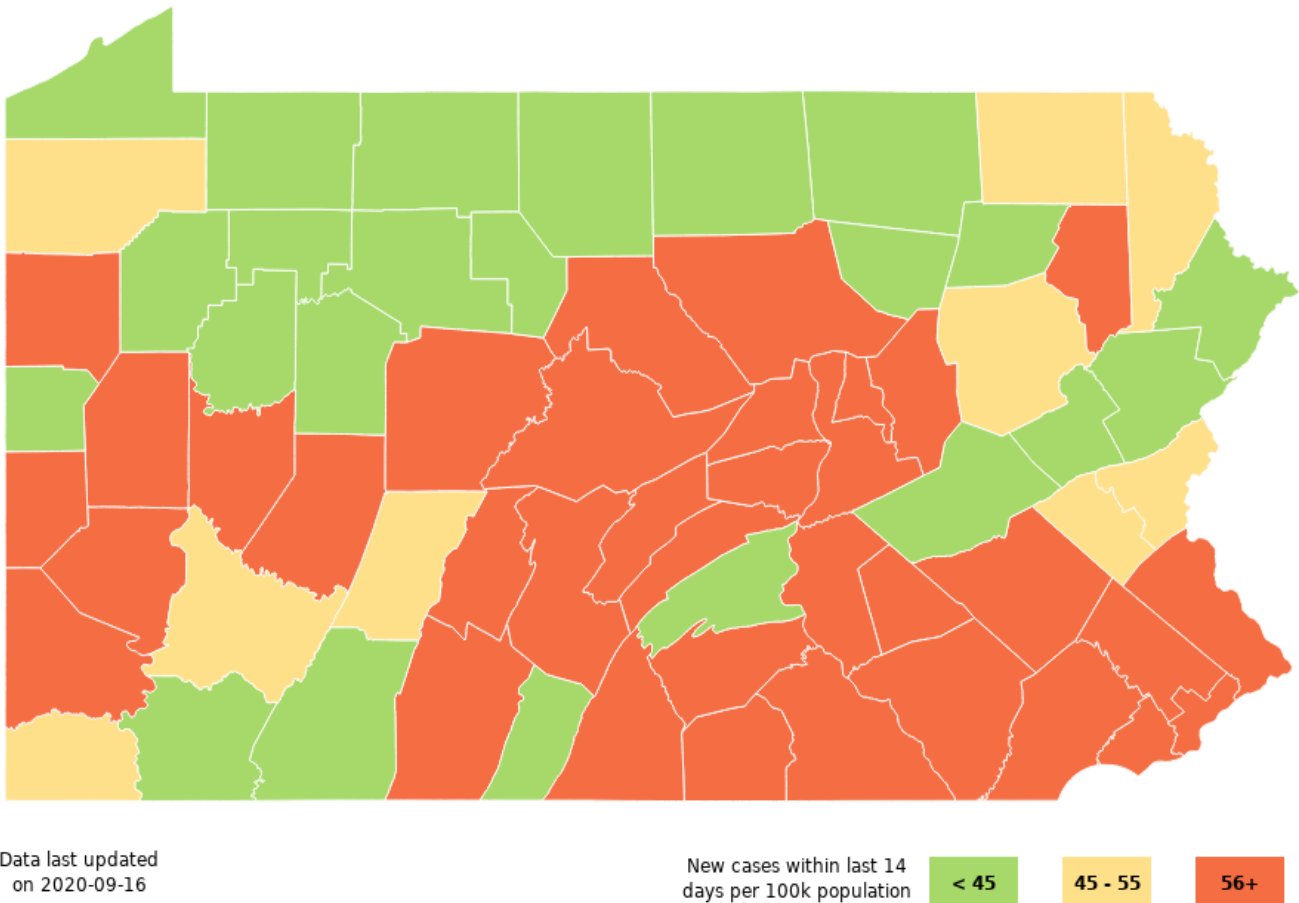
As the COVID-19 pandemic continues to paralyze the United States of America, Innovu is beginning to measure the effectiveness of the various mitigation efforts implemented at a county level. The map below depicts the number of new COVID-19 cases per 100k residents over the past 14 days in each county across the country. Each county is color coded to relatively represent the number of daily reported cases.

The target metric is achieving less than 50 new cases per 100k residents per day over a 14 day rolling window. In this map, a yellow county indicates 46-55 cases per 100k residents over the past 14 days, green indicates counties with below 45 cases per 100k residents, and red indicates counties with more than 56 cases per 100k residents.
